Exalted Ruler's Message

One hundred and fifty-eight years ago, "Blue Laws" in New York City required all bars, pubs, and theatres to close on Sundays. A group of actors and writers found a way around the law by establishing a club called the Jolly Corks. They maintained a well-stocked kitchen and plenty of liquor for their "meetings". During their first year, tragedy struck and one of their members died, leaving his family poverty-stricken. The Corks came to their aid and realized that in addition to gathering to relax over a few drinks, they could develop resources to help those in need throughout the community. In 1868, the Jolly Corks rebranded and became the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks.

Times have changed a great deal since then, but the essence of the BPOE has remained unchanged. We still meet to enjoy good company, food, and drinks. We also continue to serve the local community and those in need. Last year, Lodge 436 awarded over \$15,000 in scholarship money to students heading to universities and technical schools. We sponsored two camps at Camp Victory for Deaf and health-impaired children. We donate annually to local fire departments, police, schools, little league, animal shelters sports teams, and secure. We generously

shelters, sports teams, and scouts. We generously support our veterans financially and through sponsored events. All told, the Lodge Charity Committee committed over \$75,000 to those in need during the last fiscal year.

I hope everyone continues to enjoy the club as we grow. I hope we continue to give to others in the spirit of the Jolly Corks, as well. Keep eating, drinking, socializing, and volunteering as you are able. Maybe, in 168 years, the future newsletter will be about the things we've accomplished today.... Jim Krause
