EXALTED RULER MESSAGE

As the holiday season moves into the rear-view mirror, it's a good time to step back and appreciate the good work our lodge does at this time of the year. The spirit of giving has a year-round presence at the Bloomsburg Elks Lodge, but there is something special about the Christmas season. This year, two projects serve as examples of our service to the community and those in need.

Our local Veterans Committee partnered with the Wilkes Barre VA Medical Center to provide financial support for two critical veteran's programs. One program was developed to serve the specific social and therapeutic needs of female veterans. Our donation will help sponsor outreach and in-house activities to an often overlooked population. Additional donations were provided to the homeless veterans program at the center. Our donations will be utilized to sponsor activities and the provision of comfort, hygiene, food and clothing items. Gift bags were also provided to 60 disabled veterans at the VA and local nursing facilities.

A second project deserving mention was our Holiday Canned Food Drive. This project was seeded by a \$1000 Freedom Grant from the Elks National Veterans Committee. Donation bins were provided in six locations around town. Grant funds and local donations provided 1,362 food items to be shared with veterans experiencing food insecurity. Generous donations from within our lodge accounted for nearly 350 food items. Volunteers also helped with pick-up and delivery of every can.

I continue to be overwhelmed by the generosity demonstrated by the Charity Committee and the members of Lodge 436. Our giving is impressive on a large scale, and also appreciated on an individual level. Our lodge continues to impact people's lives in a positive way. Keep up the good work!

2026-2027 Membership Dues

Membership dues will remain the same for 2026-2027 Lodge year at \$68.00 for a Regular Member and \$48.00 for a Life Member. The breakdown of the membership dues is: \$31.00 per member to Grand Lodge for expenses and operations, the Elks Magazine, and General Liability Insurance, for a total of \$31.00 per member that must be sent to Grand Lodge by April 30, 2026. The PA Elks State Association dues are \$3.00 per member which must also be paid by April 30, 2026. This brings the total to \$34.00 of each member's dues are sent to the Grand Lodge and the Pennsylvania Elks State Association. The Bloomsburg Elks membership dues **before** the per capita to the Grand Lodge and the PA Elks State Association is \$34.00 per Regular member and \$14.00 per Life member.

The new key card for 2026-2027 will be ORANGE in color and will work in the door card lock immediately. On April 1, 2026 the door card lock will be changed to only accept the new ORANGE key card.

Dues notices will be sent out by the middle of January 2026.

From the Desk of the Secretary

Our current membership at this writing is 821 with 12 candidates awaiting initiation, which will occur on January 20, 2026, bringing our total to 833. Our current delinquent list is at 58 members whom have not yet paid their 2025-2026 lodge year membership dues. Please note that Bloomsburg Lodge has already paid the Grand Lodge Per Capita and the PA Elks State Association of \$34.00 for these members back in April 2025 for a total cost, out of our operating budget of \$1,972.00. Final notices will go out to these members in March. Please check your membership cards. We are hoping that we do not have to drop any of our members this year for non-payment-of dues. Our goal as always is to have zero lapsation and to maintain a membership of over 800, but we are going to need some help.

We would also like to know where they are. We are missing some of our fellow members and their status mostly due to lack of communication. It has been the policy of Bloomsburg Lodge to cover the membership dues of any member that is in that situation.
